

## YMCA of Metropolitan Denver School Age Child Care Options 2014-2015

We have several options to meet the needs of every family. Whether you need full time child care or care on an occasional basis, the YMCA is here to serve you. No need to worry about child care when school is not in session. Whether its in-service days or holidays, the YMCA will help care for your child when school is not in session. Take advantage of YMCA holiday camps, or try us out for summer day camps! Days and hours of care vary based on school district schedules and individual school needs.

### **As of October 1<sup>st</sup> you will not be able to switch plans.**

Here are the options you have to choose from, we hope we can accommodate your child care needs:

**\*PLAN A:** The Plan A option gives you the flexibility of choosing before school care, after school care, or both before and after school care. In addition, Plan A offers care on full days out due to teacher in-service days and Flex Days. These days vary and are determined by the specific school and district where your child attends. Plan A is available to families who need part-time care (2-3 days a week) or full-time care (4 or 5 days a week).

**\*PLAN B:** The Plan B option offers all the perks of Plan A, in addition to full-day care during several holidays and school breaks. These days vary by location, but typically include Fall Break, the two weeks for Holiday Break, and the week of Spring break as well as New Year's Eve, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Presidents Day, and Furlough Days. Plan B is available to families who need part-time care (2-3 days a week) or full-time care (4 or 5 days a week).

\*Plan B is for families that know in advance that they need full day care when school is not in session. The monthly rate is based off the number of non-contact days throughout the school year.

**\*DROP-IN CHILD CARE:** Occasionally the need for child care arises unexpectedly. Drop-in child care gives parents the opportunity to take advantage of YMCA child care on an as needed basis. Maybe something comes up at work, or you need child care twice a month – if this sounds like your schedule, this option should work best for you! This option is dependent upon current enrollment and must be approved by the Site Director. A registration fee is required for families who choose this option. The drop-in fee varies for Before, After, and Before & After depending on each schools schedule.

**HOLIDAY CAMPS:** Throughout the year a variety of days out occur – typically around the Thanksgiving holiday, holiday break, and spring break. During these times we offer a wide array of day camps for children. These camps are included in Plan B, or they can be an ala carte option. Holiday Camps are offered at a daily rate, or a weekly rate. When school's out, the YMCA is in! Days vary based on District and School Schedules.

**SUMMER DAY CAMP:** It's never too early to start thinking about summer child care. During the summer months the YMCA offers day camps at a variety of locations throughout Denver and the surrounding areas for children ages 5 - 12. We offer diverse opportunities in the form of traditional day camps, specialty camps and teen camps. Our camps include field trips, swimming, sports, arts & crafts, games, character development and much, much more.
